Negroni	11
Stirred, not shaken! This popular Italian drink is a refreshing Aperitif. Gin, Campari, sweet vermouth	
Manhattan in PDX	11
One of the never out of season classics; bourbon, vermouth, bitters and a cherry to top it all	
Hot Toddy	12
Perfect for the cold Northwest evening on our patio. Whiskey (or bourbon!), honey, lemon, orange peel and spices	
Hot Apple Cider (Seasonal)	12
Made for this crisp fall season, this warm refreshing drink is made with locally sourced apple cider, dark rum, caramel whiskey and a crisp apple garnish	
Bloodshot	13
One of our signature mixed drinks. Tequila, Cointreau, pomegranate juice & lime, salt rim.	
Caipirinha	10
This cocktail will transport you straight to the nearest Rio carnival, fiesta or beach party in Brazil. Cachaca, muddled lime, brown sugar	
Sweet & Spicy—tini	13
A perfect balance of sweet and spicy with habanero infused vodka, Alphonso mango	
Spicy Moscow Mule	11
Just a little heat to the classic cocktail; Habanero infused vodka, ginger beer, fresh lime	
Sidecar	13
Once the strength of the cognac has passed and the sweet Cointreau ends, the zesty lemon begins. This cocktail was created in Harry's bar, Paris in 1911. Cognac, Cointreau & fresh lemon juice	
Vodka va Limmo	13
One of the oldest Persian drinks. Originally was called vodka-lime. Vodka, muddled fresh mint and fresh squeezed lime juice.	
Mango Martini	12
Alphonso Mango pulp, vodka, served with fresh mangoes	
Strawberry Martini	12
Strawberry, cranberry, vodka, triple sec with a strawberry garnish	
Ray of Sunshine	12
Can't go to Hawaii yet? No one said you can't enjoy the popular island drink Mai Tai here! Rum, amaretto, pineapple and orange juices, with a pineapple garnish	
Pistachio Martini	13
Lightly sweet, sublimely different. Vanilla infused Vodka, Dissorano, Midori, Half & Half and garnished with crushed pistachios	
Spritz Veneziano	12
This refreshing Aperitif originated in Venice, brought by Austrians has Prosecco, Aperol and a splash of soda garnished with a slice of fresh orange	
Classic Martini	11
Shaken or stirred? Gin or Vodka martini either straight up or dirty with olives; choice is yours	
Espresso Martini	12
Espresso, Godiva, Kalua, Vodka, Dissorano, dusted with chocolate powder
